



BORDER BUSTERS ESC ACTION PLAN 2008/9

Forms may be submitted by any agencies, groups and organisations operating in the Cluster area to help with the creation of the Border Busters ESC Action Plan commencing April 2008 concluding March 2009.

Section 1 briefly outlines the data and statistics available relating to the Cluster area, the purpose of which is to highlight the varying needs of the Cluster community. (Up to date school data is currently being collated).

Section 2 asks that each agency outlines their priorities for the forthcoming financial year and the desired outcomes of activities/services being planned for delivery. The purpose of this section is to gain a clear picture of how different agencies are addressing the needs of the Cluster community and thus also allowing us to establish gaps that could then be addressed by the Cluster.

Section 3 requires you to think of ways in which the Cluster can support you to achieve you priorities in a non-financial way. This may take the form of publicity, coordinating/facilitating meetings or providing links into schools and other agencies to move a multi-agency agenda forward.

Section 4 asks you to make your request for funding from the Cluster to support or develop an activity or service which helps address a need in the Cluster area. This is an opportunity for agencies to submit a proposal for some of £30,000 available for improving outcomes for children, young people and families living or attending school in the Cluster area.
